Pick one category that best describes your entry. **All entries will be judged.**

- ❖ **Large Quilt:** Any technique, perimeter measures greater than 280".
- ❖ **Lap Quilt:** Any technique, perimeter measures between 160"-280".
- ❖ **Small Quilt:** Any technique, perimeter measures less than 160".
- ❖ **Modern Style Quilt:** Any size
- ❖ **Art/Improv Quilt:** Any size, non-traditional
- ❖ **Miscellaneous Sewn or Quilted:** Decor, personal or table accessories; wearables, etc.
- ❖ **Fiber Art:** Non-quilted fiber work such as knit/crochet; woven; lace; tatted; needlework; etc.
- ❖ **Youth Entry:** Fiber items created entirely by entrants under 18 years of age
- ❖ **Barn Quilt:** Wooden, 24"x24" (limit 10 entries to show)

Special Award

- ❖ Best in Show \$100

Contest Rules

- All categories will be judged except for Viewer's Choice.
- \$5 entry fee per item.
- Viewer's Choice voting will be open from 9 am until 4 pm.
- Winners will be designated by ribbons for 1st, 2nd & 3rd place. Viewer's Choice winner will be announced virtually following the show.
- Each entry may win only one award, except Best of Show.
- Entries must not have been exhibited in previous Winter Quilt Show events
- Entries should have been completed in last two years (Mar 2022-Feb 2024)
- Winter Quilt Show management reserves the right to re-categorize any entry.
- The name of every person that participated in creating the entry must be listed.
- Sleeves are not needed; entries will be hung with pinch hangers.
- Each entry must have a label with contact info on back, either permanent or temporary.
- Entries may be retrieved at the conclusion of the WQS between 4:30-5:00pm or at Wisconsin Museum of Quilts & Fiber Arts during times listed on the reverse of this form.
- Entries not claimed by March 31 become the property of WMQFA.
- Entries may be delivered to the museum during the dates and times listed.
- Delivery costs for entries not made in person are the responsibility of entrant. Return label and postage must be included and are the responsibility of the entrant.
- Limit of five entries per person.
- Entries should be submitted folded with reverse side and label showing.
